

A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5522

Ordered by the Senate June 22

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Assembly, Legislative Counsel Committee, Legislative Fiscal Officer, Legislative Revenue Officer and Commission on Indian Services for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by certain legislative branch agencies.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of legislative branch agencies; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following purposes:

(1) General program..... \$ 23,132,874

(2) Debt service..... \$ 1,768,181

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$3,150,341 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Administration Committee.

SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$11,182,173 for payment of the expenses of the following offices:

(1) The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

(2) The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the House of Representatives;

2 (3) The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives.

4 **SECTION 5.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium be-
5 ginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$14,803,583 for payment of the
6 expenses of members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

7 (2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July
8 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,672,848 for payment of the expenses of
9 members of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

10 **SECTION 6.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, including the ap-
11 propriations made by sections 4 and 5 (1) of this 2007 Act, any difference between the amount
12 appropriated by section 5 (1), chapter 714, Oregon Laws 2005, and the amount actually ex-
13 pended within the appropriation on or before June 30, 2007, is considered an appropriation for
14 payment of expenses of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

15 **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$202,969
16 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
17 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
18 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Assembly of
19 the State of Oregon.

20 **SECTION 8.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative
21 Administration Committee from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117
22 for the costs of food served in members' lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the
23 basis of sales or by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

24 **SECTION 9.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
25 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,666,603.

26 **SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
27 \$1,272,873 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
28 payment of expenses by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account
29 established by ORS 171.305 for personnel costs connected with the editing of the Oregon Re-
30 vised Statutes.

31 **SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
32 \$148,399 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
33 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
34 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
35 Committee from state agencies or other offices for bill drafting and any other legal services
36 authorized or required by law to be rendered by the Legislative Counsel Committee, including
37 duties under ORS 183.710 to 183.725 provided pursuant to policies established by the Legisla-
38 tive Counsel Committee.

39 **SECTION 12.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative
40 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from
41 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
42 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
43 Statutes, are not limited.

44 **SECTION 13.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
45 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,776,393.

1 **SECTION 14.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
2 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,835,130.

3 **SECTION 15.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
4 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$368,382.

5 **SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,109
6 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
7 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
8 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian
9 Services.

10 **SECTION 17.** This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
12 July 1, 2007.
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
