# Senate Bill 5522

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#### SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Assembly, Legislative Counsel Committee, Legislative Fiscal Officer, Legislative Revenue Officer and Commission on Indian Services for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by certain legislative branch agencies.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of legislative branch agencies; appropriating money; limiting

3 expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for the

6 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for payment

7 of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following purposes:

(1) General program...... \$ 24,014,516

9 (2) Committees and task

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- 10 forces ...... \$ 79,956
- 11 (3) Debt service ...... \$ 1,768,181

12 (4) Renovation and remodeling of

the State Capitol..... \$ 1

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 15 \$3,150,341 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for 16 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 17 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-18 ministration Committee.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative
Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies
Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$17,656,629 for payment of the expenses of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

25 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium be-26 ginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$11,785,385 for payment of the 27 expenses of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

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1 (2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, including the appropriation 2 made by section 4 of this 2007 Act, any difference between the amount appropriated by sec-3 tion 5 (1), chapter 714, Oregon Laws 2005, and the amount actually expended within the ap-4 propriation on or before June 30, 2007, is considered an appropriation for payment of 5 expenses of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

6 <u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$202,969 7 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of 8 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-9 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Assembly of 10 the State of Oregon.

11 <u>SECTION 7.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative 12 Administration Committee from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117 13 for the costs of food served in members' lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the 14 basis of sales or by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

15 <u>SECTION 8.</u> There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
16 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,098,683.

17 <u>SECTION 9.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$888,494 18 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of 19 expenses by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established 20 by ORS 171.305 for personnel costs connected with the editing of the Oregon Revised Stat-21 utes.

22SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 23\$1,386,032 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 24 25but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel Committee from state agencies or other offices for bill drafting and any other legal services 2627authorized or required by law to be rendered by the Legislative Counsel Committee, including duties under ORS 183.710 to 183.725 provided pursuant to policies established by the Legisla-28tive Counsel Committee. 29

30 <u>SECTION 11.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative 31 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from 32 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies 33 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised 34 Statutes, are not limited.

35 <u>SECTION 12.</u> There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
36 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,070,473.

37 <u>SECTION 13.</u> There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium 38 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,682,277.

39 <u>SECTION 14.</u> There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
40 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$368,382.

41 <u>SECTION 15.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,109 42 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of 43 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-44 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian 45 Services.

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- 1 <u>SECTION 16.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
- 2 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect

3 July 1, 2007.

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
