

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5522

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for  
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for  
4 payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee for the following pur-  
5 poses:

6 (1) General program..... \$ 23,132,874

7 (2) Debt service..... \$ 1,768,181

8 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
9 \$3,150,341 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for  
10 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
11 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-  
12 ministration Committee.

13 “**SECTION 3.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative  
14 Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies  
15 Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.

16 “**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-  
17 ning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$11,182,173 for payment of the ex-  
18 penses of the following offices:

19 “(1) The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-  
20 sentatives;

21 “(2) The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the House of Representatives;  
22 and

23 “(3) The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Rep-  
24 resentatives.

25 “**SECTION 5.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium  
26 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$14,803,583 for payment of the  
27 expenses of members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

28 “(2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July  
29 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,672,848 for payment of the expenses of  
30 members of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

31 “**SECTION 6.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, including the ap-  
32 propriations made by sections 4 and 5 (1) of this 2007 Act, any difference between the amount  
33 appropriated by section 5 (1), chapter 714, Oregon Laws 2005, and the amount actually ex-  
34 pended within the appropriation on or before June 30, 2007, is considered an appropriation for  
35 payment of expenses of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

1        **“SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
2 \$202,969 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for  
3 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
4 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative As-  
5 sembly of the State of Oregon.

6        **“SECTION 8.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative  
7 Administration Committee from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117  
8 for the costs of food served in members’ lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the  
9 basis of sales or by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

10       **“SECTION 9.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the  
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,666,603.

12       **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
13 \$1,272,873 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for  
14 payment of expenses by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account  
15 established by ORS 171.305 for personnel costs connected with the editing of the Oregon Re-  
16 vised Statutes.

17       **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
18 \$148,399 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for  
19 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
20 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel  
21 Committee from state agencies or other offices for bill drafting and any other legal services  
22 authorized or required by law to be rendered by the Legislative Counsel Committee, including  
23 duties under ORS 183.710 to 183.725 provided pursuant to policies established by the Legisla-  
24 tive Counsel Committee.

25       **“SECTION 12.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Legislative  
26 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from  
27 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies  
28 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised  
29 Statutes, are not limited.

30       **“SECTION 13.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium  
31 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,776,393.

32       **“SECTION 14.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium  
33 beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,835,130.

34       **“SECTION 15.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the  
35 biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$368,382.

36       **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,109  
37 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of  
38 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
39 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian  
40 Services.

41       **“SECTION 17.** This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
42 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect  
43 July 1, 2007.”.
