

# SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5530

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
3 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment  
4 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
5 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Parks and Recre-  
6 ation Department, for the following purposes:

- 8 (2) Grant programs ..... \$ 11,266,913
- 9 (3) Operations..... \$ 63,472,259
- 10 (4) Facility repair and

- 13 (6) Oregon State Fair operations ... \$ 10,598,392
- 14 (7) Recreation programs and  
15 planning ..... \$ 3,183,808

16 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
17 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment  
18 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to  
19 the State Parks and Recreation Department for the following purposes:

- 20 (1) Administration..... \$ 10,117,713
- 21 (2) Land acquisition..... \$ 22,139,224
- 22 (3) Grant programs ..... \$ 15,785,682
- 23 (4) Operations..... \$ 11,754,979
- 24 (5) Facility repair and  
25 maintenance..... \$ 24,563,998
- 26 (6) Heritage conservation..... \$ 3,381,952
- 27 (7) Oregon State Fair operations ... \$ 3,510,848
- 28 (8) Oregon State Fair debt  
29 service..... \$ 4,235,070
- 30 (9) Recreation programs and  
31 planning ..... \$ 3,292,595

32 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
33 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limits for payment  
34 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Parks and Recreation De-  
35 partment for the following purposes:

1	(1) Administration.....	\$	993
2	(2) Grant programs .....	\$	3,183,655
3	(3) Operations.....	\$	1,387,437
4	(4) Facility repair and		
5	maintenance.....	\$	1,546,665
6	(5) Heritage conservation.....	\$	1,988,024

7       **“SECTION 4. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**  
9 **July 1, 2007.”.**
