

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5545

3 **“JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT**

4
5 **“SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
6 made to the Judicial Department by section 1 (2), chapter 604, Oregon Laws 2005, for the
7 biennium ending June 30, 2007, as modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by
8 \$1,657,462 for increased costs for sign and spoken language interpreters in the court system.

10 **“PUBLIC DEFENSE SERVICES COMMISSION**

11
12 **“SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
13 made to the Public Defense Services Commission by section 1 (2), chapter 552, Oregon Laws
14 2005, for the biennium ending June 30, 2007, as modified by Emergency Board action, is in-
15 creased by \$1,057,517 for public defense contract services for the remainder of the biennium
16 ending June 30, 2007.

18 **“DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE**

20 **“SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
21 made to the Department of Justice by section 1, chapter 694, Oregon Laws 2005, for the
22 biennium ending June 30, 2007, as modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by
23 \$443,663 for the purpose of paying for legal costs through February 2007 of protecting the
24 state’s interest in Master Settlement Agreement payments.

26 **“OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR**

28 **“SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
29 made to the Office of the Governor by section 1, chapter 719, Oregon Laws 2005, for the
30 biennium ending June 30, 2007, as modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by
31 \$46,200 for the purpose of replacing necessary office equipment.

33 **“DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES**
34 **AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT**

1 **“SECTION 5. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Department**
2 **of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for the payment of expenses from fees,**
3 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and**
4 **federal funds, for the biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on expenditures for the**
5 **department established by section 2 (1), chapter 792, Oregon Laws 2005, as modified by**
6 **Emergency Board action, is decreased by \$120,000.**

7 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Department of Commu-**
8 **nity Colleges and Workforce Development for the payment of expenses from fees, moneys**
9 **or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal**
10 **funds, for the biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on expenditures by the depart-**
11 **ment for the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps established by section 2 (2), chapter 792,**
12 **Oregon Laws 2005, as modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by \$120,000.**

14 **“DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

16 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Department of**
17 **Higher Education for the payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, includ-**
18 **ing Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, for the biennium**
19 **ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on expenditures for the department established by sec-**
20 **tion 2 (1), chapter 781, Oregon Laws 2005, as amended by section 2a (1), chapter 781, Oregon**
21 **Laws 2005, and as modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by \$3,000,000.**

23 **“DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

25 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Department of**
26 **Transportation for the payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including**
27 **Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds, for the**
28 **biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitations on expenditures for the department estab-**
29 **lished by section 2, chapter 721, Oregon Laws 2005, as modified by Emergency Board action,**
30 **are increased by the following amounts for the following purposes:**

31 **“(1) The limitation for maintenance and emergency relief programs under section 2 (2),**
32 **chapter 721, Oregon Laws 2005, is increased by \$10,074,515.**

33 **“(2) The limitation for the highway safety program under section 2 (5), chapter 721,**
34 **Oregon Laws 2005, is increased by \$4,473,122.**

35 **“(3) The limitation for special programs under section 2 (8), chapter 721, Oregon Laws**
36 **2005, is increased by \$4,911,997.**

37 **“(4) The limitation for public transit under section 2 (14), chapter 721, Oregon Laws 2005,**
38 **is increased by \$1,481,000.**

39 **“SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Department of**
40 **Transportation for the payment of expenses of the department from federal funds, for the**
41 **biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on expenditures by the department for driver**
42 **and motor vehicle services established by section 3 (7), chapter 721, Oregon Laws 2005, as**
43 **modified by Emergency Board action, is increased by \$80,000.**
