## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5549

<u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General
Fund, the amount of \$30,000,000 for the purposes for which the Emergency Board lawfully
may allocate funds.
