

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 571

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 3, delete the second “and”.
- 2 In line 4, after “433.865” insert “; and prescribing an effective date”.
- 3 After line 7, insert:
- 4 “(1) ‘Cigar bar’ means a business that:
- 5 “(a) Has on-site sales of cigars as defined in ORS 323.500;
- 6 “(b) Has a humidor on the premises;
- 7 “(c) Allows the smoking of cigars on the premises but prohibits the smoking of all other tobacco
- 8 products in any form including, but not limited to, loose tobacco, pipe tobacco, cigarettes as defined
- 9 in ORS 323.010 and cigarillos as defined by the Department of Human Services by rule;
- 10 “(d) Has been issued and operates under a full on-premises sales license issued under ORS
- 11 471.175;
- 12 “(e) Prohibits persons under 21 years of age from entering the premises and posts notice of the
- 13 prohibition;
- 14 “(f) Does not offer video lottery games as authorized under ORS 461.217;
- 15 “(g) Has a maximum seating capacity of 40 persons;
- 16 “(h) Has a ventilation system that is certified by the assistant to the State Fire Marshal de-
- 17 scribed in ORS 476.060 for the jurisdiction in which the cigar bar is located as adequate to remove
- 18 the cigar smoke in the cigar bar and vents the smoke from the cigar bar in a manner that prevents
- 19 the smoke from entering any other establishment; and
- 20 “(i) Requires all employees to read and sign a document that explains the dangers of exposure
- 21 to secondhand smoke.”.
- 22 In line 8, delete “(1)” and insert “(2)”.
- 23 In line 12, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.
- 24 In line 20, delete “(3)” and insert “(4)”.
- 25 In line 24, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)”.
- 26 On page 2, line 3, delete “lottery games” and insert “video lottery games as authorized under
- 27 ORS 461.217”.
- 28 In line 6, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.
- 29 On page 3, after line 10, insert:
- 30 “(d) Smoking is permitted in a cigar bar that generated on-site retail sales of cigars of at least
- 31 \$5,000 for the calendar year ending December 31, 2006.
- 32 “(e) Smoking is permitted in a race course as defined in ORS 462.010 unless prohibited by the
- 33 licensed race meet operator.”.
- 34 On page 7, after line 23, insert:
- 35 “**SECTION 15. This 2007 Act takes effect on January 1, 2009.**”.
