

**SENATE MINORITY REPORT
AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 571**

May 17

President Courtney:

A minority of your Committee on Finance and Revenue, to whom was referred A-engrossed Senate Bill 571, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that it do pass with the following amendments:

1 On page 3 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 10, insert:

2 “(d) Smoking is permitted in rooms or halls being used by a charitable, fraternal or religious
3 organization to conduct bingo games under a license issued pursuant to ORS 464.270.

4 “(e) Smoking is permitted in a race course as defined in ORS 462.010 unless prohibited by the
5 licensed race meet operator.

6 “(f) Smoking is permitted in a completely enclosed area of a restaurant, bar or tavern if:

7 “(A) The area is completely separated from the rest of the restaurant, bar or tavern and has
8 doors that are open only when a person is entering or exiting the enclosed area;

9 “(B) The area has a ventilation system that is certified to be adequate to remove the secondhand
10 smoke in the enclosed area by the assistant to the State Fire Marshal described in ORS 476.060 for
11 the jurisdiction in which the restaurant, bar or tavern is located;

12 “(C) The area is part of a restaurant, bar or tavern that indicates in all advertising for the
13 restaurant, bar or tavern that the smoking of tobacco products is permitted in the establishment;

14 “(D) The area has no more than four video lottery game terminals;

15 “(E) The restaurant, bar or tavern prohibits persons under 21 years of age from entering the
16 premises and posts notice of the prohibition;

17 “(F) The restaurant, bar or tavern has been issued and operates under a full on-premises sales
18 license issued under ORS 471.175; and

19 “(G) The area is served only by employees who have read and signed a document that explains
20 the dangers of secondhand smoke.”.
