SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Repeals sunset on provisions permitting carrier to deny coverage for preexisting condition in individual health benefit plan.]

Repeals sunset on provisions permitting insurance carrier to limit individual health benefit plan in which individual may elect to enroll and on provisions permitting insurance carrier to offer to insure applicant under health benefit plan other than plan initially elected by applicant.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to individual health benefit plans; repealing section 5, chapter 590, Oregon Laws 2003.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 5, chapter 590, Oregon Laws 2003, is repealed.
