Senate Bill 591

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Allows health care provider or state health plan to charge clerical fee for copying patient health records. Increases maximum amount that may be charged for each page copied.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to charges for copying patient health records; amending ORS 192.521. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 192.521 is amended to read: 4 192.521. A health care provider or state health plan that receives an authorization to disclose 5 6 protected health information may charge: 7 (1)(a) A flat clerical fee of \$21 for each request; and 8 (b) No more than [\$25 for copying 10 or fewer] 91 cents per page for the first 30 pages of 9 written material and no more than [25] 69 cents per page for each additional page; (2) Postage costs to mail copies of protected health information or an explanation or summary 10 of protected health information, if requested by an individual or a personal representative of the 11 12 individual; and 13 (3) Actual costs of preparing an explanation or summary of protected health information, if requested by an individual or a personal representative of the individual. 14
