

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 629

1 Delete lines 5 through 17 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 137.183 is amended to read:

3 “137.183. (1) [*Notwithstanding ORS 82.010,*] Judgments in criminal actions bear interest at the
4 rate **provided in ORS 82.010.** [*of 12.5 percent per annum from the date of entry of the judgment for*
5 *the first five years and four percent per annum thereafter.*] The clerk of the court shall calculate in-
6 terest on each category of monetary obligation established by ORS 137.295 for the purpose of dis-
7 tribution of the interest in the manner provided in ORS 137.295. **Except as provided in subsection**
8 **(2) of this section,** interest shall accrue monthly on the first day of each month, beginning with the
9 first day of the second full calendar month after the monetary obligation first becomes due.

10 “(2) **When a person is sentenced to a term of imprisonment, interest on a judgment in**
11 **a criminal action does not begin to accrue until the first day of the second full calendar**
12 **month after the person’s initial release from custody following the sentencing in which the**
13 **monetary obligation was imposed.”.**
