Authorizes persons engaged in lawful activity to stand ground and use force in self-defense.

2	Relating to self-defense.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 161.190 to
5	161.275.
6	SECTION 2. A person has no duty to retreat and may stand the person's ground and
7	meet force with force, including deadly physical force, if:
8	(1) The person is not engaged in an unlawful activity; and
9	(2) The use of force is otherwise justified by ORS 161.209 or 161.219.
10
