Senate Bill 676

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits insurer from refusing claim on basis that claim was submitted by physician assistant rather than by supervising physician.
Repeals sunset provision.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 743.725 is amended to read:
6	743.725. (1) [No insurer shall] An insurer may not refuse a claim solely on the ground that the
7	claim was submitted by a physician assistant [practicing under the circumstances set forth in ORS
8	677.515 (4)] rather than by the supervising physician for the physician assistant.
9	(2) This section is exempt from ORS 743.700.
10	SECTION 2. Section 2, chapter 446, Oregon Laws 2003, is repealed.
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
