

# Senate Bill 680

Sponsored by Senator METSGER; Senators BEYER, DEVLIN, MONNES ANDERSON, MORSE, Representatives SCHAUFLER, WITT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to develop 25-year plan to enhance opportunities for angling in Oregon. Requires department to provide full-time equivalent employee to work on angling matters.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department to pay costs of 25-year plan and full-time employee.

Sunsets January 2, 2010.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to angling; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall develop a 25-year plan**  
5 **to enhance opportunities for angling in Oregon. In developing the plan, the department shall**  
6 **consider topics including but not limited to:**

7 (a) **Methods to enhance angling opportunities throughout the state;**

8 (b) **Effects of increased population in the state on current and future angling opportu-**  
9 **nities;**

10 (c) **Strategic marketing to promote the recruitment of new anglers;**

11 (d) **Development of pilot programs to promote angling throughout the state; and**

12 (e) **Any other topic deemed relevant by the department.**

13 (2) **All governmental agencies shall cooperate with the department and furnish such in-**  
14 **formation and advice as the department considers necessary in carrying out the provisions**  
15 **of this 2007 Act.**

16 (3) **The department shall present the plan to the Seventh-fifth Legislative Assembly in**  
17 **the manner required by ORS 192.245 no later than February 1, 2009.**

18 **SECTION 2. The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall employ at least one full-time**  
19 **equivalent employee for work, under the direction of the State Fish and Wildlife Director,**  
20 **related to topics set forth in section 1 of this 2007 Act.**

21 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
22 **ated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,**  
23 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ to pay the costs of the 25-year plan de-**  
24 **scribed in section 1 of this 2007 Act and the full-time equivalent employee described in sec-**  
25 **tion 2 of this 2007 Act.**

26 **SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2007 Act are repealed on January 2, 2010.**

27 **SECTION 5. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
28 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
