SUMMARY

Creates offense of restrictive confinement of calf or pig. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

26 27 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

- (a) "Calf" means a bovine animal that is raised for the purpose of marketing or distributing the meat, organs or any part of the animal as a food product labeled as veal.
 - (b) "Pig" means a porcine animal of a type maintained as livestock.
- (c) "Turning around freely" means having the ability to turn in a complete circle in an enclosure without an impediment, including a tether, and without touching any side of the enclosure.
- (2) A person commits the offense of restrictive confinement of a calf or a pig if the person confines a calf or a pig for more than 12 hours during any 24-hour period in a manner that prevents the calf or the pig from:
 - (a) Lying down and fully extending its limbs; or
- (b) Turning around freely. 15
 - (3) Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to:
 - (a) A calf or a pig that is being transported;
- (b) A calf or a pig in a rodeo exhibition, a state or county fair exhibition or a similar 18 19 exhibition;
 - (c) A calf or a pig during the slaughtering process;
 - (d) A calf or a pig during lawful scientific or agricultural research;
 - (e) A calf or a pig during an examination, operation or test by a veterinarian or during temporary treatment for veterinary purposes; or
 - (f) A pig in the seven-day period before the pig farrows.
 - (4) The offense of restrictive confinement of a calf or a pig is a Class A misdemeanor.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act applies to confinement of a calf or a pig that occurs on or after January 1, 2012.
