

Senate Bill 695

Sponsored by Senator WALKER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires person who provides cellular communication service or other wireless communication services to provide information on location of cellular telephone or other wireless communication device served by person if information is requested by sheriff or deputy sheriff, municipal police officer or Oregon State Police officer and information is needed because of imminent threat of death or serious bodily injury.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 759.**

5 **SECTION 2. Any person who provides cellular communication service or other wireless**
6 **communication services must provide all information available to the person relating to the**
7 **location of a cellular telephone or other wireless communication device served by the person**
8 **if the information is requested by a sheriff or deputy sheriff, a municipal police officer or**
9 **an Oregon State Police officer and the information is needed because of an imminent threat**
10 **of death or serious bodily injury to any person.**
