

# Senate Bill 714

Sponsored by Senator MONROE; Senators FERRIOLI, G GEORGE, L GEORGE, MORRISETTE, MORSE, NELSON, Representatives D EDWARDS, FLORES, GILLIAM, JENSON, KRUMMEL, WHISNANT, WITT (at the request of Independent Employer Association)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Legislative Counsel to solicit bids for printing of Oregon Revised Statutes each biennium.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the printing of Oregon Revised Statutes; creating new provisions; amending ORS 171.275;  
3 and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 171.275 is amended to read:

6 171.275. (1) Each biennium, the Legislative Counsel, under the direction of the Legislative  
7 Counsel Committee, shall publish and distribute the Oregon Revised Statutes, including an index and  
8 annotations.

9 **(2) Each biennium, the Legislative Counsel shall solicit bids for the printing of the**  
10 **Oregon Revised Statutes.**

11 [(2)] **(3)** The Legislative Counsel Committee shall establish policies for the revision, clarification,  
12 classification, arrangement, codification, annotation, indexing, printing, binding, publication, copy-  
13 righting, sale and distribution of the publications referred to in subsection (1) of this section.

14 [(3)] **(4)** The Legislative Counsel Committee shall establish the charges necessary to recover the  
15 costs of publishing the materials sold and distributed under this section.

16 **SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 171.725 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to the**  
17 **printing of the 2007 Edition of the Oregon Revised Statutes and all subsequent editions.**

18 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**  
20 **on its passage.**
