

Senate Bill 749

Sponsored by Senator MORRISETTE; Senator KRUSE, Representatives BOONE, SCHAUFLER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services to supplement moneys otherwise available for area agencies on aging.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of the Department of Human Services; appropriating money; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Assembly finds that home and community based care for**
6 **senior citizens is a wise investment of state moneys and that investment of moneys in pro-**
7 **grams provided by area agencies on aging and described in ORS 410.070 (2) will help restore**
8 **Oregon's nationally recognized model of such home and community based care.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2007 Act shall be known as the Older Oregonians Act of 2007.**

10 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
11 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of**
12 **the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which shall be used by the department to sup-**
13 **plement funds otherwise appropriated to the department for the purposes described in ORS**
14 **410.070 (2).**

15 **SECTION 4. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
17 **July 1, 2007.**
