(1) The State Board of Education shall adopt by rule requirements for the 3 process that a school district must use when the district receives a complaint pertaining to whether a school in the district is a standard school as defined in ORS 327.006. 4 "(2) The rules adopted by the board shall require school districts to establish and imple-5 6 ment a process for the prompt resolution of a complaint and shall require the process to: "(a) Have specific timelines for the completion of the process by both the district and the 7 person making the complaint; 8 9 "(b) Have a specific time period within which the district must make a final decision on 10 a complaint, after which the final decision on the complaint may be appealed to the Superintendent of Public Instruction; and 11 "(c) Recognize that if a district does not provide a written decision within the specific 1213 time period, failure to provide such a decision will be regarded as the district's final decision. "SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 14 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 1516 July 1, 2007.". 17
