Senate Bill 781

Sponsored by Senator BEYER; Senators JOHNSON, NELSON, Representatives GILLIAM, JENSON, ROBLAN, SCHAUFLER (at the request of East Valley Water District)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Water Resources Department for construction of reservoir and conveyance system in East Valley Water District.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to East Valley Water District; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

Whereas intense crop production on high value farmland in east Marion and south Clackamas Counties depends on water from a declining basalt aquifer and over appropriated surface water sources; and

Whereas the East Valley Water District has studied importing water from the Detroit Dam storage, recharging ground water and constructing new storage and found construction of new storage to be the most effective alternative to relieve stress on the existing resources; and

Whereas the East Valley Water District has reviewed a number of possible storage sites and, after completing preliminary environmental and engineering studies, determined an area on Drift Creek in Marion County to be economically and environmentally feasible; and

Whereas the East Valley Water District does not seek to develop additional agricultural production, but instead seeks to replace existing stressed resources; and

Whereas population increases in existing communities have put an additional demand on resources; now, therefore,

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

- <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Water Resources Department shall construct a reservoir and conveyance system in the East Valley Water District.
- (2) Prior to construction, the department shall complete engineering and environmental assessments and secure the permits required to begin construction.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the Water Resources Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$______ for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2007 Act.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
