Senate Bill 785

Sponsored by Senator L GEORGE, Representative THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds for financing transportation improvement projects. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

| 3 | Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: |
| 4 | SECTION 1. As used in sections 2 and 3 of this 2007 Act, "transportation improvement |
| 5 | projects" or "projects" means the following: |
| 6 | (1) Property acquisition to construct a bypass between Newberg and Dundee; |
| 7 | (2) An environmental impact statement for the Interstate 5 and Highway 99 West Con- |
| 8 | nector Project; |
| 9 | (3) An environmental impact statement for the Sunrise Corridor Project; |
| 10 | (4) An environmental impact statement for the Marion Street bridge project in Salem; |

| 12 | (5) An environmental impact study for the Center Street bridge project in Salem. |
| 13 | SECTION 2. (1) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, at the request of the Director |
| 14 | of Transportation, the State Treasurer may issue lottery bonds pursuant to ORS 286.560 to |
| 15 | 286.580 in the amount of \$150 million for payment of the expenses of the Department of |
| 16 | Transportation for transportation improvement projects, plus an additional amount to be |
| 17 | estimated by the State Treasurer for payment of bond-related costs incurred by the Depart- |
| 18 | ment of Transportation and the State Treasurer. |
| 19 | (2) The bond-related costs incurred by the Department of Transportation and the State |
| 20 | Treasurer for the lottery bonds authorized by this section shall be paid from the gross pro- |
| 21 | ceeds of the lottery bonds and from allocations for the purposes of ORS 286.576 (1)(c). |
| 22 | SECTION 3. The Legislative Assembly finds that: |
| 23 | (1) The transportation improvement projects will accomplish the purpose of creating jobs |
| 24 | and furthering economic development in Oregon because the completion of the transporta- |
| 25 | tion improvement projects will: |
| 26 | (a) Reduce traffic congestion on existing highways and roads, improving the attrac- |
| 27 | tiveness to new businesses and supporting the operations and prosperity of existing busi- |
| 28 | nesses; and |
| 29 | (b) Reduce the cost and time required for family wage earners to commute to work, |
| 30 | permitting more of Oregon's workforce to obtain jobs for which those workers are qualified. |
| 31 | (2) The factors described in subsection (1) of this section will encourage and promote |

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1 economic development within the State of Oregon, and issuance of lottery bonds to finance

2 the transportation improvement projects is therefore an appropriate use of state lottery

3 funds under section 4, Article XV of the Oregon Constitution, and ORS 461.510.

4 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 5 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 6 July 1, 2007.

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
