## Senate Bill 792

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for Retired and Senior Volunteer Program.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to Retired and Senior Volunteer Program; appropriating money; and declaring an emer-
3	gency.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
6	ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of
7	the General Fund, the amount of \$, which may be expended for the Retired and Sen-
8	ior Volunteer Program.
9	SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services may expend moneys appropriated under
10	section 1 of this 2007 Act for the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program, including:
11	(1) Support services for senior citizens and persons with disabilities;
12	(2) Academic tutoring, mentoring and social support in public schools and community
13	colleges;
14	(3) Community policing, crime prevention and safety for senior citizens and persons with
15	disabilities; and
16	(4) Marketing and outreach geared toward the future civic engagement of the generation
17	of people born between 1946 and 1964, commonly known as the baby boom generation.
18	SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
20	July 1, 2007.
