SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to monitor compliance of state agencies with statutory requirements relating to conformity of agency rules with federal law and statutory requirements relating to agency review of new rules within five years after adoption of rule.

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 183.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall monitor the

6 compliance of agencies with the requirements of ORS 183.332 and 183.405. The department

7 shall make a report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 every

8 two years on the findings of the department relating to agency compliance with the re-9 quirements of ORS 183.332 and 183.405.

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
