SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Establishes State Police Patrol Division Fund. Requires biennial appropriation from General Fund of specified percentage of General Fund revenues. Appropriates money from General Fund for biennium beginning July 1, 2007.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

- Relating to funding for the Department of State Police; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Whereas public safety is, and ought to be, the first priority of Oregon's citizens; and
- Whereas funding has historically not been provided to maintain sufficient Patrol Division numbers to provide adequate public safety in Oregon; and
- Whereas the Oregon State Police Patrol Division has been reduced by approximately 50 percent over the last 25 years while Oregon's population has increased by approximately 38 percent; and
- Whereas Oregon's methamphetamine addiction problem has created serious statewide personal property and personal injury law enforcement problems; and
- Whereas the Oregon State Police Patrol Division is our first line of defense for interdiction of interstate trade in methamphetamine; and
 - Whereas current Patrol Division numbers are insufficient to provide 24-hour police service; and Whereas current Patrol Division numbers are insufficient to provide safe back-up protection for the division's own personnel; now, therefore,
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The State Police Patrol Division Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the State Police Patrol Division Fund shall be credited to the fund. Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Department of State Police to fund patrol activities and to pay related administrative costs.
 - (2) For each biennium, the Legislative Assembly shall appropriate to the State Police Patrol Division Fund from the General Fund an amount equal to one percent of the amount of General Fund revenues for that biennium as predicted in the last revenue forecast given to the Legislative Assembly prior to adjournment sine die of the regular session.
 - SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the State Police Patrol Division Fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2007 Act.
