Senate Bill 802

SUMMARY

Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to study issues relating to sale of property used for Oregon State School for the Blind.

4	SECTION 1. (1) During the 2007-2009 biennium, the Superintendent of Public Instruction
5	shall study issues relating to the sale of the property that is used for the Oregon State
6	School for the Blind.
7	(2) The superintendent shall report to the interim committees on education about the
8	study prior to October 1, 2008.
