## Senate Bill 813

Sponsored by Senator BATES

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Establishes surcharge on point source permit fees. Continuously appropriates moneys to Department of Environmental Quality to fund monitoring of nonpoint sources of pollution.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to monitoring nonpoint sources of pollution; creating new provisions; amending ORS
3	468B.051; and appropriating money.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 468B.051 is amended to read:
6	468B.051. (1) Not more than once each calendar year, the Environmental Quality Commission
7	may increase the fees established under ORS 468.065 for permits issued under ORS 468B.050. The
8	amount of the annual increase may not exceed the anticipated increase in the cost of administering
9	the permit program or three percent, whichever is lower.
10	(2) A surcharge of \$ is added to the fee for each permit issued by the Department
11	of Environmental Quality to regulate point source activities. The surcharge collected under
12	this subsection shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of an account of the
13	department. The collected surcharges are continuously appropriated to meet the expenses
14	of the department incurred in regulating nonpoint sources of pollution.
15	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 468B.051 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to
16	permits issued on or after January 1, 2008.
