SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Requires mass transit district or transportation district that operates light rail system to install crossing gates at unguarded pedestrian crossings of light rail tracks.]

Requires Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon to commission independent study to make findings and recommendations regarding pedestrian crossing safety.

Relating to light rail.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon shall commission a study by an independent person with expertise in light rail system safety to review a representative sample of the pedestrian crossings of the district's light rail system and make findings and recommendations to the district regarding the safety of the pedestrian crossings.
