Senate Bill 875

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires posting of 100 percent bond for removal and restoration in order to obtain permit to operate wave energy facility.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to wave energy facilities; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 543. SECTION 2. The Water Resources Commission shall require that an applicant file a bond 5 with an application for a license to operate a facility that generates electricity from wave 6 7 energy and is located within Oregon's territorial sea, as defined in ORS 196.405. The com-8 mission may not accept a bond for a sum that is less than 100 percent of the projected cost for removing the facility and performing any necessary restoration. 9 10 SECTION 3. This 2007 Act applies to all applications to operate a wave energy facility issued on or after July 1, 2007. 11 SECTION 4. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 12

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect

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July 1, 2007.
