

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 879

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “409.510” insert “, 409.520”.
- 2 After line 30, insert:
- 3 “**SECTION 3.** ORS 409.520 is amended to read:
- 4 “409.520. (1) The Pain Management Commission shall consist of 19 members as follows:
- 5 “(a) Seventeen members shall be appointed by the Director of Human Services. Prior to making
- 6 appointments, the director shall request and consider recommendations from individuals and public
- 7 and private agencies and organizations with experience or a demonstrated interest in pain manage-
- 8 ment issues, including but not limited to:
- 9 “(A) Physicians licensed under ORS chapter 677 or organizations representing physicians;
- 10 “(B) Nurses licensed under ORS chapter 678 or organizations representing nurses;
- 11 “(C) Psychologists licensed under ORS 675.010 to 675.150 or organizations representing psy-
- 12 chologists;
- 13 “(D) Physician assistants licensed under ORS [677.495 to 677.545] **chapter 677** or organizations
- 14 representing physician assistants;
- 15 “(E) Chiropractic physicians licensed under ORS chapter 684 or organizations representing
- 16 chiropractic physicians;
- 17 “(F) Naturopaths licensed under ORS chapter 685 or organizations representing naturopaths;
- 18 “(G) Clinical social workers licensed under ORS 675.510 to 675.600 or organizations representing
- 19 clinical social workers;
- 20 “(H) Acupuncturists licensed under ORS 677.759;
- 21 “(I) Pharmacists licensed under ORS chapter 689;
- 22 “(J) Palliative care professionals or organizations representing palliative care professionals;
- 23 “(K) Mental health professionals or organizations representing mental health professionals;
- 24 “(L) Health care consumers or organizations representing health care consumers;
- 25 “(M) Hospitals and health plans or organizations representing hospitals and health plans;
- 26 “(N) Patients or advocacy groups representing patients; [and]
- 27 “**(O) Dentists licensed under ORS chapter 679;**
- 28 “**(P) Occupational therapists licensed under ORS 675.210 to 675.340;**
- 29 “**(Q) Physical therapists licensed under ORS 688.010 to 688.201; and**
- 30 “[~~(O)~~] **(R)** Members of the public.
- 31 “(b) Two members shall be members of a legislative committee with jurisdiction over human
- 32 services issues, one appointed by the President of the Senate and one appointed by the Speaker of
- 33 the House of Representatives. Both members shall be nonvoting, ex officio members of the commis-
- 34 sion.
- 35 “(2) The term of office of each member is four years, but a member serves at the pleasure of the

1 appointing authority. Before the expiration of the term of a member, the appointing authority shall
2 appoint a successor whose term begins on July 1 next following. A member is eligible for reap-
3 pointment. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appointment
4 to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.”.

5 On page 2, line 1, delete “3” and insert “4”.

6 After line 13, insert:

7 **“SECTION 5. Dentists licensed under ORS chapter 679, occupational therapists licensed**
8 **under ORS 675.210 to 675.340 and physical therapists licensed under ORS 688.010 to 688.201**
9 **must complete one pain management education program described under ORS 409.510:**

10 **“(1) Within 24 months of the effective date of this 2007 Act; or**

11 **“(2) Within 24 months of the first renewal of the person’s license after the effective date**
12 **of this 2007 Act.”.**

13 In line 14, delete “4” and insert “6”.

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
