## Senate Bill 923

Sponsored by Senator WESTLUND

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases maximum cost of facility eligible for renewable energy resource facility tax credit certification.

## **3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** ORS 469.200 is amended to read:

469.200. The total cost of a facility that receives a preliminary certification from the Director 5 6 of the State Department of Energy for tax credits in any calendar year shall not exceed [\$10] \$10.1 7 million. The director shall determine the dollar amount certified for any facility and the priority 8 between applications for certification based upon the criteria contained in ORS 469.185 to 469.225 9 and applicable rules and standards adopted under ORS 469.185 to 469.225. The director may consider the status of a facility as a research, development or demonstration facility of new renewable re-10 source generating and conservation technologies or a qualified transit pass contract in the deter-11 12 mination. SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 469.200 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to facil-13

14 ities that receive certifications on or after January 1, 2008.

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
