Senate Bill 939

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires local detention facilities to comply with accreditation standards involving health care. Requires Department of Corrections to adopt rules specifying standards.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to detention facilities.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A local correctional facility or lockup, as those terms are defined in ORS 5 169.005, shall use an accredited health care system in providing health services to persons 6 arrested and detained in the local correctional facility or lockup.

7 (2) The Department of Corrections shall adopt by rule the accreditation standards of at 8 least one nationally recognized board that accredits corrections health care systems. The 9 standards may include those promulgated by the National Commission on Correctional 10 Health Care.

(3)(a) A local correctional facility or lockup, as those terms are defined in ORS 169.005,
that does not use an accredited health care system shall adopt such a system no later than
July 1, 2008.

(b) A local correctional facility or lockup that uses an accredited health care system shall
maintain the existing accreditation or comply with the rules adopted by the department un der subsection (2) of this section.

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
