

Senate Bill 947

Sponsored by Senator MORSE; Senator GORDLY, Representative SCOTT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Transportation Commission to adopt standards for posting signs that will provide directional information to any accredited university or college in Oregon.

Relating to signs.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Transportation Commission shall adopt uniform standards for posting signs providing drivers directional information to any accredited university or college in Oregon.

(2) The commission is authorized to provide a uniform system of posting signs within the boundaries of the state.

(3) All signs placed shall conform to specifications approved by the commission. The commission may use signs that show internationally recognized and approved symbols.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
