Prohibits sale of water-based motor vehicle engine coolants containing ethylene glycol or polyethylene glycol.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to engine coolants.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A person may not sell a substance containing ethylene glycol or 5 polyethylene glycol for use as a water-based engine coolant for motor vehicles as defined in 6 ORS 801.360.

7 (2) The Department of Environmental Quality may impose a civil penalty for a violation

8 of subsection (1) of this section. The civil penalty may not exceed \$1,000 per occurrence. Civil

9 penalties under this subsection shall be imposed in the manner provided by ORS 183.745.
