## Senate Bill 991

Sponsored by Senator WHITSETT; Senator CARTER, Representatives BOQUIST, COWAN (at the request of Oregon Veterinary Medical Association)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Exempts application of pesticides by licensed veterinarian or veterinary technician from requirements of pesticide use reporting system.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to pesticides; amending section 2, chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999.

## **3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 SECTION 1. Section 2, chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999, is amended to read:

5 Sec. 2. As used in sections 2 to 11 [of this 1999 Act], chapter 1059, Oregon Laws 1999:

6 (1) "Pesticide" has the meaning given in ORS 634.006, but does not include antimicrobial pesti-

7 cides as defined in the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, 7 U.S.C. 136 (P.L. 92-516,

8 as amended).

9 (2) "Pesticide user":

(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, means any person who uses or
applies a pesticide in the course of business or any other for-profit enterprise, or for a governmental
entity, or in a location that is intended for public use or access.

(b) Does not mean a veterinarian or veterinary technician who applies a pesticide while
acting within the scope of a license issued under ORS chapter 686.

(3) "Retail pesticide dealer" means a person who sells, offers for sale, handles, displays or dis tributes any pesticide but is not licensed as a pesticide dealer under ORS 634.112.
