## Senate Bill 994

Sponsored by Senator JOHNSON (at the request of Governor Theodore R. Kulongoski)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Appropriates moneys from General Fund for Oregon Public Broadcasting and Oregon Arts Commission.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Oregon Public Broadcasting, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:
    - (1) \$2.75 million for building digital transmission towers around the state; and
  - (2) \$1 million to defray Oregon Public Broadcasting's costs of transmitting its signals to rural Oregon.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Economic and Community Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4.2 million for the Oregon Arts Commission, which may be expended for the Creative Oregon Initiative.

SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
