

# Senate Concurrent Resolution 11

Sponsored by Senator GORDLY

## SUMMARY

In memoriam: Judge Clifford L. Freeman, 1944-2006.

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2       Whereas Multnomah County Circuit Judge Clifford L. Freeman, who was born on June 2, 1944,  
3 passed away on August 21, 2006; and

4       Whereas Judge Clifford L. Freeman received an undergraduate degree in economics, a master's  
5 degree in education and a law degree from the University of Oregon; and

6       Whereas Judge Clifford L. Freeman served as a felony trial attorney for the Metropolitan Public  
7 Defender's office from 1979 to 1988; and

8       Whereas Judge Clifford served as a pro tempore Juvenile Court Referee for Multnomah County  
9 before he was appointed to the bench in 1996; and

10       Whereas Judge Clifford L. Freeman was one of the driving forces behind the development of  
11 Multnomah County's Community Court Project that brought courtrooms into neighborhoods to han-  
12 dle crimes that were not considered high profile; and

13       Whereas Judge Clifford L. Freeman was the first judge to preside over the Northeast Community  
14 Court, based at the King Neighborhood Facility in Northeast Portland; and

15       Whereas as presiding judge of the Northeast Community Court, Judge Clifford L. Freeman found  
16 ways that defendants could aid the community as part of their sentence; and

17       Whereas Judge Clifford L. Freeman was known to his colleagues as personifying the qualities  
18 of a good judge, a public servant and a mentor; now, therefore,

19 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

20       That we, the members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly, extend our deepest sympa-  
21 thies to Judge Clifford L. Freeman's family, friends and all those persons whose lives he affected  
22 in the community he served.
