

Senate Concurrent Resolution 12

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

In memoriam: Halim Rahsaan, 1943-2006.

2 Whereas Halim Rahsaan, formerly known as William Earl Cross, was born on May 12, 1943, and
3 passed away on July 7, 2006; and

4 Whereas after graduating from Jefferson High School in 1961, Halim Rahsaan enlisted in the
5 United States Army; and

6 Whereas Halim Rahsaan, after being honorably discharged from the Army, attended Southern
7 Illinois University and Lewis and Clark College where he received numerous certificates and honors;
8 and

9 Whereas Halim Rahsaan began boxing at the Knott Street Community Center where his boxing
10 team, the Knott Street Boxing Club, won three national titles; and

11 Whereas the Knott Street Boxing Club, of which Halim Rahsaan was a member, was inducted
12 into the Oregon Sports Hall of Fame in 2005; now, therefore,

13 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

14 That we, the members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly, express our deep condolences
15 to the family of Halim Rahsaan.
