## **Senate Joint Resolution 10**

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with presession filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Secretary of State Bill Bradbury)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to modify double majority voting requirement in property tax elections so that double majority requirement does not apply to property tax measures after June 19, 2008.

Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at special election held on same date as next primary election.

<b>2</b>	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
3	PARAGRAPH 1. The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section
4	11k to be added to and made a part of Article XI, such section to read:
5	SECTION 11k. Notwithstanding subsection (8) of section 11 of this Article, subsection (8)
6	of section 11 of this Article does not apply to any measure voted on in an election held after
7	June 19, 2008.

9	PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the
10	people for their approval or rejection at a special election held throughout this state on the

11 same date as the next primary election.
