Senate Joint Resolution 34

Sponsored by Senator G GEORGE (at the request of Oregon State Grange)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require that regular sessions of Legislative Assembly adjourn sine die before June 1 of each odd-numbered year and to prohibit payment to member of Legislative Assembly of per diem or other additional amount by reason of service during session after June 1 of odd-numbered year and before start of next regular session.

Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

JOINT RESOLUTION

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: 2

PARAGRAPH 1. Section 10, Article IV of the Constitution of the State of Oregon, is amended 3 to read:

5 Sec. 10. The regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held biennially at the Capitol of the State commencing on the second Monday [of September, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty 6 7 eight, and on the same day of every second year thereafter, unless a different day shall have been ap-8 pointed by law.] in January of each odd-numbered year. Each regular session must adjourn sine die before June 1 of that year, and a member of the Legislative Assembly may not be 9 paid per diem or any other additional amount by reason of service during a regular session 10 of the Legislative Assembly after June 1 of the odd-numbered year and before the start of 11 12 the next regular session.[-] 13

PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the 14 15people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout this state. 16
