

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 36**

1 After line 1 of the printed joint resolution, insert:

2 “Whereas today’s global economy provides both benefits and challenges to Oregon; and

3 “Whereas international trade is a dominant part of the Oregon economy and provides important
4 markets for many Oregon businesses; and

5 “Whereas this state’s growing educational and cultural diversity means that we are increasingly
6 aware of our global partners; and

7 “Whereas ambassadors who represent Oregon in foreign markets would assist the International
8 Trade Commission and the Economic and Community Development Department in important duties;
9 and

10 “Whereas designating ambassadors for Oregon who would visit foreign markets and receive
11 representatives of foreign markets would enhance Oregon’s presence in the global community and
12 benefit the state’s economy and people; now, therefore,”.

13 Delete lines 3 through 10 and insert:

14 “That we, the members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly, encourage the Governor to
15 designate state ambassadors to represent Oregon in foreign markets and to visit foreign markets and
16 receive representatives from those markets; and be it further

17 “Resolved, That we encourage the Governor, from funds available to the Governor, to reimburse
18 the state ambassadors for actual and necessary expenses, including travel expenses, incurred in the
19 performance of the ambassadors’ official duties for the state.”.
