BACKGROUND: Lyle Swetland worked as a printer for more than 20 years at the Eugene Register-Guard and became an advocate for labor and education in Lane County. He served in executive roles with the Lane County Labor Council and the Oregon AFL-CIO. Mr. Swetland also promoted the establishment of Lane Community College and served on its first board of directors. Mr. Swetland died on November 26, 2007 at the age of 88.
