**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Adjourns sine die special session of Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Possible amendment to the resolution

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The Public Commission on the Oregon Legislature recommended in November 2006 that the legislature experiment with the timing and structure of sessions before asking voters to incorporate an annual session structure in the Oregon Constitution.

Senate Concurrent Resolution 1 (2007) established deadlines for the Legislative Assembly to complete their regular session work including sine die by June 29, 2007. The resolution also established a process by which the Legislative Assembly would call an emergency session to begin on February 4, 2008 and adjourn no later than February 29, 2008.
