EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Audrey Owen McCall was born in Spokane, Washington in 1915 and married Tom McCall in May 1939. The McCall's had two sons, Thomas Jr. and Samuel. Mrs. McCall was referred to as the "family rudder, the symbol of discipline and authority." Mrs. McCall was also the state's First Lady and full partner with Governor McCall from 1967 to 1975. After the former Governor's death, she worked to carry on Governor McCall's legacy. Mrs. McCall died on November 24, 2007 at the age of 92.
