SUMMARY

Modifies deadline for Secretary of State to file information with county clerks regarding [offices, candidates and measures] candidates for offices of President and Vice President of United States at November 2008 general election.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 254.085, for purposes of the general election to be held
5	in November 2008, the Secretary of State, not later than the 55th day before the date of the
6	general election, shall file with each county clerk a statement containing information re
7	garding candidates for the offices of President and Vice President of the United States.
8	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2008 Act is repealed on January 2, 2009.
9	SECTION 3. This 2008 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2008 Act takes effect
11	on its passage.
