House Bill 3602

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ELECTIONS, ETHICS AND RULES (at the request of House Interim Committee on Elections, Ethics and Rules)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Modifies deadline for Secretary of State to file information with county clerks regarding offices, candidates and measures at November 2008 general election.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A	RILL	FOR	AN	ACT

- 2 Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 254.085, for purposes of the general election to be held in November 2008, the Secretary of State, not later than the 55th day before the date of the general election, shall file with each county clerk:
 - (1) A statement of the state and congressional district offices to be filled in the county at the election, information concerning all candidates for the offices, and the state measures to be voted on, as described in ORS 254.085; and
 - (2) A statement containing information regarding candidates for the offices of President and Vice President of the United States.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2008 Act is repealed on January 2, 2009.
 - SECTION 3. This 2008 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2008 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
