

House Concurrent Resolution 100

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ELECTIONS, ETHICS AND RULES (at the request of House Interim Committee on Education)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

In memoriam: Martha Anne Dow, 1939-2007.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

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2 Whereas Martha Anne Dow was born on January 3, 1939, and passed away on September 29,
3 2007, after a valiant six-month battle with breast cancer; and

4 Whereas Martha Anne Dow became the fifth president of the Oregon Institute of Technology in
5 1998, after serving there for six years as Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs; and

6 Whereas Martha Anne Dow graduated from Montana State-Northern, received her master's de-
7 gree in microbiology from Montana State University and received her Ph.D. in microbiology from
8 the University of Hawaii at Honolulu; and

9 Whereas Martha Anne Dow, before joining the Oregon Institute of Technology, taught for 25
10 years in the fields of biology, microbiology, environmental science and water quality; and

11 Whereas Martha Anne Dow received the Distinguished Service Award for Outstanding Service
12 from the Klamath County Chamber of Commerce and the Candice Richard Award for outstanding
13 contributions to economic development from the Klamath County Economic Development Associ-
14 ation; and

15 Whereas, under Martha Anne Dow's leadership, enrollment at the Oregon Institute of Technol-
16 ogy increased by almost 1,000 students and programs in engineering, computer science, applied
17 health fields and geothermal power grew to meet Oregon's needs; and

18 Whereas Martha Anne Dow recognized the growing shortages in applied health care in Oregon,
19 leading her to actively support more programs and skills training at the Oregon Institute of Tech-
20 nology, and her efforts resulted in the naming of the Martha Anne Dow Oregon Center for Health
21 Professions; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

22 That we, the members of the Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly, in special legislative session
23 assembled, express our deepest sympathy to the family of Martha Anne Dow; and be it further
