

Senate Bill 1073

Sponsored by Senator JOHNSON (at the request of Housing Alliance) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Housing and Community Services Department for specified purposes. Requires that some of appropriated moneys be transferred into continuously appropriated account.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to financial administration of the Housing and Community Services Department; appropri-
3 ating money; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
6 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,**
7 **2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____.** The department shall transfer the
8 moneys appropriated under this section into the Housing Development Account for expendi-
9 ture to provide loans and payments under the statutes identified in section 5 (3), chapter 757,
10 Oregon Laws 2007, for the purpose of preserving the state's existing supply of affordable
11 housing units.

12 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
13 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,**
14 **2009, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$750,000, which may be expended for the pur-**
15 **pose of providing resources and support to counties to reduce or end homelessness.**

16 **SECTION 3. This 2008 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2008 Act takes effect**
18 **on its passage.**
