Senate Bill 1078

Sponsored by Senator METSGER; Senator WESTLUND (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs State Parks and Recreation Department to erect and maintain one or more monuments or other suitable markers on grounds of State Capitol State Park to commemorate and honor Indian tribes. Directs department to consult with Commission on Indian Services and federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon. Directs department to obtain funding from private sources. Takes effect July 1, 2008.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to state parks; and prescribing an effective date.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. (1) To commemorate and honor Indian tribes, the State Parks and Recreation Department shall plan, erect and maintain one or more monuments or other suitable markers that are sited within, and are compatible with, the Walk of the Flags on the grounds of the State Capitol State Park.
- (2) The department shall consult with the Commission on Indian Services and each of the federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon in carrying out its duties under this section.
- (3) The department shall carry out its duties under subsection (1) of this section only after obtaining funding from private sources.
- 12 SECTION 2. This 2008 Act takes effect on July 1, 2008.
