SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Permits juvenile court to suspend or revoke driving privileges of youth offenders adjudicated for traffic offenses that have suspension or revocation penalties for adult traffic offenders.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to juvenile driving privileges; amending ORS 809.412. 2 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: **SECTION 1.** ORS 809.412 is amended to read: 4 5 809.412. A determination by a juvenile court that a child within its jurisdiction has committed 6 any act that is grounds for suspension or revocation of driving privileges under ORS 809.409 or 7 809.411 or other law or ordinance regulating the operation of motor vehicles is equivalent to 8 a conviction, and the juvenile court has the same authority to order suspensions of driving privi-9 leges and take other actions in relation to the driving privileges of the child as other courts have 10 in relation to adult traffic offenders.
