

# Senate Bill 1088

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits juvenile court to suspend or revoke driving privileges of youth offenders adjudicated for traffic offenses that have suspension or revocation penalties for adult traffic offenders.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to juvenile driving privileges; amending ORS 809.412.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 809.412 is amended to read:

5 809.412. A determination by a juvenile court that a child within its jurisdiction has committed  
6 any act that is grounds for suspension or revocation of driving privileges under ORS 809.409 or  
7 809.411 **or other law or ordinance regulating the operation of motor vehicles** is equivalent to  
8 a conviction, and the juvenile court has the same authority to order suspensions of driving privi-  
9 leges and take other actions in relation to the driving privileges of the child as other courts have  
10 in relation to adult traffic offenders.
